For this we say a very big “thank you” for the wonderful support you continue to give us. Thank you so much.

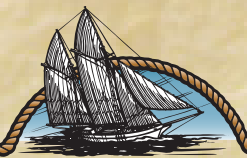


## CHRISTMAS HOLIDAY BREAK
